

On Wednesday 21 September 2022, Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI), along with the Cyprus Productivity Centre (CCP) and the European Association for Career Guidance (EACG), organised a national event regarding the "European Centre of Professional Excellence in Microelectronics", under the European project ECoVEM, where local stakeholders, like policymakers, education leaders in VET and HE, as well as companies and SMEs were invited.
